Easte Gate Organization specializes in sustainable development and capacity building by providing support to the government, decision makers and society. It provided training courses in many fields, including financial education (FE), how to start, improve, and manage a project within the (SIYB) program, programs for preparing budgets and financial statements, cash flows, and the "Think Cooperatively" and "Start cooperation" programs, specialized in establishing Cooperative associations and making them successful according to the rules of modern project management, and public relations and communication programs for leaders the civil society organizations and state directorates.

The organization's programs included many beneficiaries, including more than 600 beneficiaries only in Nineveh Governorate, in addition to hundreds of beneficiaries from the governorates of: Baghdad, Basra, Babylon, Salah al-Din, al-Anbar, Diyala, Kirkuk, Erbil, Dohuk, and Sulaymaniyah.

Among the beneficiaries were **government employees** from governorate offices and councils, **members of governorate councils**, directors of service departments, members of chambers of industry, academics, heads of Non-Governmental Organizations, businessmen, and others.

For three days, from August 15–17, 2023, under the auspices of the General Secretariat of the Cabinet, the Department of Non-Governmental Organizations, presented (the Public Relations Program) to the leaders of civil society organizations and relevant state directorates, including employees and some security services of the Nineveh Governorate Office.









#### Training and qualifying of individuals and establishments:

Under the auspices of the Presidency of Nineveh Provincial Council, East Gate Organization for Sustainable Development held an intensive training workshop on the basic tasks of local governments between responsibilities, powers and challenges for ladies and gentlemen members of the Nineveh Provincial Council in February 2024 in Mosul.





#### **Research and Studies:**

East Gate Organization prepared important research and studies to develop the economic sector in Nineveh in cooperation with the College of Administration and Economics at the University of Mosul, including a study of the quality of private health services in Mosul, which is the first survey study for this sector. It also issued a study on (the Reality of Private Banks) in Iraq and a study on (Education and Investment) in Iraq, a study on the (Causes and Repercussions of Unemployment among Holders of University Degrees) in Iraq, a study on (Real Estate Development) in Iraq, challenges and investment opportunities, as well as many feasibility studies for agricultural, commercial and industrial projects.

#### **Conferences and Forums:**

East Gate organized the Private Health Services Forum in Nineveh for three days, October 24-26, 2023, under the patronage of His Excellency the Iraqi Minister of Health, with the participation of the Mosul Center for Culture and Science, and the University of Mosul, and the support of private hospitals, which included workshops and an exhibition of health services. The forum was attended by the Chairman of the Health and Environment Committee in the Iraqi Parliament, the Secretary-General of the Iraqi Parliament, the Head of the Nineveh Health Department and the Head of Baghdad Al-Karkh Health Directorate, on behalf of His Excellency the Minister of Health, the President of the University of Mosul, the President of the University of Nineveh, the representative of the Non-Governmental Organizations Directorate in the General Secretariat of the Cabinet, and the representative of the Syndicate of University Academics in Nineveh, with a group of college deans and presidents of departments.

Easte Gate Organization also participated in many international and local forums. Including the Al-Rafidain Forum in the Iraqi capital, Baghdad, from September 26-29, 2022, and the Human Capital Conference in Iraq on October 25, 2024, at the University of Mosul.

#### East Gate in the United Nations Human Rights Council

In response to the invitation of the Human Rights Council of the United Nations General Assembly, East Gate for Sustainable Development participated in the 55th session of the Council from March 15 to April 5, 2024 at the Palais des Nations in Geneva, Switzerland.

The organization's participation was based on affirming the right to development as the manifestation of the totality of political, economic, civil and cultural human rights, and denouncing the violations occurring in the occupied Palestinian territories.

The side meetings resulted in more relations and clarification of the role of civil society organizations specialized in sustainable development to defend the right to development for all.

This team consists of an elite group of consultants and experts with long experience in implementing local government programs for three electoral cycles 2005–2014, which includes providing technical support and consultations to both the provincial council and the provincial office through training on field work, courses and workshops, and providing technical consultations in the areas of legislation and planning.
